SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE FIFTH SESSION
OF NWFP ASSEMBLY TUESDAY 12TH AUGUST
2008 (REQUISITION SESSION).

The fifth session was summoned by Mr. Speaker on receipt of requisition signed by 61 members of the Provincial Assembly of NWFP under clause (3) of Article 54 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

2. Mr. Kiramatullah Khan, Speaker assumed the chair at 10:43 A.M. and proceedings commenced with recitation from the Holy Qur'an.

Mr. Bashir Ahmad Bilour, Senior Minister after his speech requested for suspension of rules to move resolutions regarding impeachment of President. The House allowed to move a resolution. Mr. Akram Khan Durrani, Leader of the Opposition, Mr. Rahim Dad Khan, Senior Minister and Pir Muhammad Sabir Shah, MPA moved a resolution and was passed per majority. The votes in favour of the resolutions were 107 and vote against the resolution were 4.
