

**PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF KHYBER**  
**PAKHTUNKHWA.**  
**SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE 15<sup>th</sup> SESSION**  
Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2010
