"China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) is a fortune changer project. All the people of Pakistan fully support this project. The project got controversial when the original route was changed. The Provincial Assembly passed unanimous resolution in this regard. Outside the Provincial Assembly a number of seminars, conference, walks and protests were held to restore the original route of the corridor.

On 28th May an all parties conference (APC) was held in Islamabad under the Chair of Honorable Prime Minister Mr. Nawaz Sharif. The APC evolved a mile stone consensus. The Honorable Prime Minister Mr. Nawaz Sharif, announced the consensus himself. He declared that the western route will be the route of the corridor and will be competed first and named the cities & towns which came on way of the western route.

Subsequently maps issued and allocations of the Federal Budget have created doubts regarding the western route. According to present plans the western route will remain the same old single road of National Highway. The budget allocations are mainly for the Eastern route. The rest of the allocations are to connect this route to Gawadar on one hand and Karakoram Highway (KKH) on the other.

The Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa resolves and recommends to the Federal Government that the National consensus evolved on 28th May 2015 should be implemented in letter and spirit. Any deviation from the decisions of the APC will not be acceptable to the people of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, moreover it will create disharmony amongst the federating units of Pakistan."

8. Resolution No. 710 Ms. Meraj Hamayum Khan, MPA was unanimously passed by the House:-

Primary School Teachers

"Primary level is the most important level in the education process as it lays down the foundation on which the later tiers work and build a system that contributes to the healthy, physical, moral, emotional and social character of the individual. Everywhere in the world special care is taken in the hiring of teachers who are held in great esteem by the parents who work closely with them as well as the community around them. Contrary to this primary school teachers in our country do not enjoy respect and recognition that is due to them. Not only this they are also subjected to bias and discrimination in incentives and benefits which are far less than other categories of teaching staff. This has created a lot of frustration among the Primary School Teachers (PSTs) especially the senior ones and those who are highly qualified with MA, MSC and Med degrees which is adversely affecting their performance.

This august House demands that the Provincial Government should adopt immediate measures to enhance the status of PSTs by giving them their due rights, scales and incentives as well as direct the media to positively and regularly project the importance of PSTs in the whole education system. Some decisions requiring immediate implementation are.

1. Pay Scales according to qualifications i.e Scale 15 for undergraduates, Scale 16 for Graduates and 17 for Masters.
2. Trainers for Primary Teachers should be selected from among PSTs.
3. PSTs should be given a share in appointment of Subject Teachers (SS).
4. Merit should be introduced at the District and Tehsil levels."

9. Resolution No. 711 Ms. Aamma Sardar, MPA was unanimously passed by the House:-
