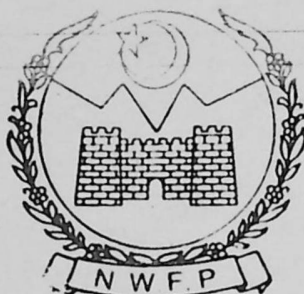

THE NORTH-WEST FRONTIER PROVINCE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002.

N.-W.F.P. ORDINANCE NO. XXXIX OF 2002.

AN ORDINANCE

*further to amend the North-West Frontier Province
Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1978.*

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the North-West Frontier Province Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1978 (N.-N.W.F.P. Ord. No. XI of 1978), for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of the North-West Frontier Province is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of Emergency of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, as amended uptodate, and the Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999, read with Article 4 of the Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him that behalf, the Governor of the North-West Frontier Province is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:

1. **Short title and commencement.**— (1) This Ordinance may be called the North-West Frontier Province Public Service Commission (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 2002.

(2) It shall come into force at once, and shall be deemed to have taken effect on the 9th day of August, 2002.

2. Amendment of section 4 of N.-W.F.P. Ord. No. XI of 1978.— In the North-West Frontier Province Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1978 (N.-W.F.P. Ord. No. XI of 1978), in section 4, in sub-section (1), for the word "five", the word "four" shall be substituted.
