“This August House unanimously recommends that the Provincial Government shall form a Parliamentary Minority Caucus of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Assembly comprising the Honorable Members. The aim of the Parliamentary Minority Caucus is;

- To enhance the role of minority lawmakers in the parliamentary businesses;
- To promote and recommend laws and policies for eradication of all forms of discrimination against non-Muslims;
- To advocate for revision of all the discriminatory laws which are against the basic provision of international human rights conventions;
- To work for introduction of a regulatory framework in the province on human rights including the rights of minorities;
- To raise awareness and sensitize the Honorable Members of the Provincial Assembly of the issues related to minorities and.
- To advocate in the Provincial Assembly for allocation of special funds in the annual budget for the uplift and socio-economic well being of minorities.”
