





further to amend the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mines and Minerals Act, 2017.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient further to amend the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mines and Minerals Act, 2017 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXXVI of 2017), for the purposes to continue and revise royalty rates of certain minerals in the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;

It is hereby enacted by the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as follows:

**1. Short title and commencement.**---(1) This Act may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mines and Minerals (Second Amendment) Act, 2024.

(2) It shall come into force with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2024

**2. Amendment of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXXVI of 2017.**---In the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mines and Minerals Act, 2017 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXXVI of 2017), in Schedule-IV-A, in the table,-

- (a) under the heading "**PRECIOUS METALS AND OTHER METALLIC MINERALS GROUP**", against Serial Nos. 1 and 2, in Column No. 3, under the sub-heading "**Royalty Rates**", for the existing entries, the following shall respectively be substituted, namely:

"Rs.800 per ton.
Rs.500 per ton.";

- (b) under the heading "**FUEL MINERALS**", against Serial No. 1, in Column No. 3, under the sub-heading "**Royalty Rates**", for the existing entry, the following shall be substituted, namely:

"Rs.500 per ton.";

- (c) under the heading "**PRECIOUS AND SEMI-PRECIOUS GEM STONES GROUP**", against Serial No. 3, in Column No. 3, under the sub-heading "**Royalty Rates**", for the existing entry, the following shall be substituted, namely:

"Rs.50 per kg."; and

- (d) for the heading "**CONSTRUCTION AND INDUSTRIAL MINERAL GROUP**", and for the existing entries, thereunder the following shall respectively be substituted, namely:


