It is essential to optimize the trade system through Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the primary gateway for cross-border commerce. This optimized system should include modernized customs, digitized documentation, and real-time digital monitoring to address inefficiencies such as smuggling and under-invoicing. Resuming and streamlining trade will create jobs, reduce poverty, and improve tax revenues, allowing KP's provincial government to invest in infrastructure and public services. This will also reduce KP's dependency on federal funds, foster investment, and promote economic growth by expanding access to Afghan and Central Asian markets. Strong transparency measures, including automated customs processes and digital tracking, are critical for ensuring accurate tax collection, preventing revenue leakages, and building business confidence. This House resolves that the Government of Pakistan, in collaboration with the provincial government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Afghan authorities, shall take necessary steps to restore and optimize Pakistan-Afghanistan trade.
