Kohistan region (Upper Kohistan, Lower Kohistan and Koral Palas) and Torghar districts are backyard of KPK as well as Hazara division marred with very low literacy rate, negligible basic amenities and almost nonexistence of job opportunities. KTF has worked very closely with civil administration since its employment to identify major issues leading to weak governance in these areas.

2. It is further mentioned that first formal session of PTF was held on 9 February 2022 in Peshawar. Second session of PTF was held on 15 November 2022 in Peshawar. Headquarters 10 Corps and 28 Brigade attended the conference via PATS.
